Negotiations continue between USW and NDCU

Following six days of negotiations in May and June, bargaining continues at an optimistic pace between USW Local 1-405 and the Nelson and District Credit Union.

Both parties have issues still on the table that need to be dealt with but the amount of those issues is getting smaller. Progress has been made in getting closer to a fair collective agreement.

Both committees will take some time to look at their positions and respond when talks resume in July. There could be some delays in trying to accommodate all of the participants' vacation over the summer months of July and August but both parties are looking at their schedules to resume bargaining.

Bargaining is scheduled to resume in Nelson in July.
